

Application for Financial Support for University Co-operative Education

The Walkerton Clean Water Centre (Centre) is committed to supporting human resources needs by supporting university co-operative education students who have secured unpaid co-op placements in the drinking water industry.

The Walkerton Clean Water Centre will award financial support in the amount of \$12.00 per hour to the students with successful applications. The support will be paid over the duration of the co-op placement, up to a maximum of four months.

Eligibility

1. The applicant shall be a full time undergraduate student of a university in Ontario, studying in engineering or science.
2. The co-op placement shall be at a drinking water facility, an industry involved in drinking water, or the Centre's Technology Demonstration Facility.
3. The Centre will provide financial support to the successful applicant on the condition that the applicant is not receiving funding for the co-op placement from another source.
4. The applicant should be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident in Canada.
5. The Centre will not provide assistance to applicants to find a co-op placement employer.
6. The Walkerton Clean Water Centre assumes no responsibility for liability and workplace safety insurance coverage for applicants. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that adequate coverage is in place prior to starting the co-op placement.

Conditions for the Successful Applicant

Upon notification of a successful application, the applicant shall submit to the Centre:

1. An official letter from the university certifying enrolment in a full time undergraduate program;
2. A letter of acceptance signed by the employer;
3. An official transcript of all undergraduate course work.
